Why Is Teambuilding

Important?

When two or more people work together, they will either be a **good team** or **bad team**.

- Good teams produce better results than bad teams.
- The quality of a team affects morale, job satisfaction, retention, adaptability, client satisfaction and overall organizational / group performance.



When To Use

Teambuilding?

Only with relatively **new** or relatively **healthy** teams.

- Teambuilding can help create a strong foundation and strengthen an adequately function team.
- Teambuilding is not a cure all for the many problems that can affect a team – poor individual performance, interpersonal conflict, inadequate supervision, unclear goals, discrimination, lack of appreciation, etc.
