Project that appears to be less than 16 hours of effort is billed using time and materials

Projects over 16 hours go thru a formal quote process containing a proposal, phased payment terms based on deliverables and a signature.

RATE

The standard rate for non-profits for time and material is \$145 an hour.

PROJECTS

Projects are estimated after some initial requirements are provided. The price is determined based on the value provided to the client.
